



Festival FAQ Sheet

- **Is there an entry fee for the festivals?**

We charge a £50 entry fee per club for the festivals. Enter as many age groups and teams as you can. It is still only £50 per club.

- **Where is the festival taking place?**

Unless we state otherwise, the festival will be on the pitches around Sixways Stadium. The location map will be sent to you with the festival pack by email.

- **Is car parking available onsite?**

There is limited parking onsite. Please see website below for details. Parking must be purchased in advance of attending the festival as there won't be available space on the day. Car sharing is highly recommended.

- **How many matches will teams get?**

This depends on the number of teams participating. We aim to get in as many games as possible within regulations, and to put teams in groups with other teams you wouldn't normally play against.

- **Do we need to provide referees?**

This depends on the number of teams and availability of referees. We aim to get referees for festivals but due to the number of matches we may allocate clubs to referee games so that we can facilitate as many games as possible for the players.

- **Are discounted tickets available for festival entrants?**

- **Are there opportunities to be mascots or take part in the guard of honour before the match at the stadium?**

- **What are the timings for the day?**

This will depend on the number of participating teams, but general timings are 10am-2pm. The exact timings will be released to you in your packs around week before the event.

- **What facilities do you have in case of bad weather?**

When able to use the Worcester RFC ground we have access to their showers, toilets and their catering. So in case of bad weather, parents can take shelter in the clubhouse and the children will be able to get showered and changed after the festival, for the game up at the stadium. If not at Worcester RFC we will inform Clubs of the plans.

- **Can we bring Gazebos and tents etc?**

Yes, you can bring anything for shelter for the day. Please ensure these are a safe distance from any playing or training areas.
