Background

Premiership Rugby Club Worcester Warriors in partnership with the RFU and Herefordshire and Worcestershire Sports Partnership are extending their commitment to the development of Rugby Union across the region. This post has been developed to increase participation in rugby in the Herefordshire & Worcestershire area with a particular focus on 16+ / adult participation and coach education. The post will look to enhance the quality of coaching in the area and provide opportunities for social / leisure rugby activities that will engage a different target audience than is usually involved in rugby.

General:

First class awareness of the game of rugby union is a pre-requisite and it you will have experience of successfully planning and delivering rugby activities in an Education and / or Community setting. A rugby enthusiast, with excellent communication and presentation skills who has experience of working with a wide range of clientele is vital as is a willingness to acquire and undertake new skills.

Qualifications/Experience:

Preferably educated to degree level or with equivalent qualifications and specifically Rugby Union qualifications the successful candidate will have first hand experience of organising and delivering rugby specific programmes. Computer literacy with keyboard skills is essential, as is experience and knowledge of the community sporting infrastructure. Candidates should have or be close to achieving a Level 2 Rugby Union Coach Qualification and preferably have experience of mentoring, coach development and tutoring.















Specific Role:

- 1. Delivery of Rugby Union activities in Curricular and Extra Curricular time in club and community settings
- 2. To set-up and run a Further Education programme of coaching within local Colleges leading to a Countywide Colleges festival and fixtures
- 3. Encourage and foster links between the FE Colleges and local Clubs
- 4. Support a programme of Coach / Teacher Education within the FE Colleges and Clubs to ensure sustainability of the programme
- 5. Develop and enhance the current Worcester Warriors Touch Rugby programme. Focusing on encouraging new players to the game in an effort to achieve the minimum 1% increase in participation
- 6. Stimulate and facilitate coach development in the Junior and Amateur sections of the local Clubs.
- 7. Provide further opportunities for people to take part in contact and leisure rugby by specifically targeting local businesses and organisations for their participation.
- 8. Deliver the RFU CSLA bolt-on at local FE Colleges to encourage a new generation of players, coaches and volunteers
- 9. To support the Worcestershire MLD Schools coaching programme and provide teacher education opportunities within the schools.
- 10. Support the delivery of the Worcestershire Masterclass player development programme on behalf of the Worcestershire Rugby Development Group
- 11. To continually develop, monitor and review the programme and produce the necessary reports
- 12. To support Warriors Community Match Day activities and involve beneficiaries of the Community Programme in the match day event
- 13. Represent rugby to the wider public and local businesses with a view to involving new stakeholders in the game
- To undertake any other duties deemed commensurate with the post and as directed by the Community Manager, Steering Group, General Manager, CEO and / or the company.

The proposed post will be employed and line managed by Worcester Warriors with a steering group of the Worcester Warriors, the RFU and the Herefordshire & Worcestershire County Sports Partnership which will meet quarterly to monitor the post.
